The C2R2 traineeship works with research-based Masters and Ph.D. students in Rutgers' Earth system sciences, social sciences, and engineering graduate programs to build the skills needed to address real-world resilience issues in the face of climate change. The trainee program offers students the opportunity to conduct research that integrates natural, socio-economic, and engineered elements of coastal systems and to practice effective communication techniques with coastal stakeholders.
